Leash-up/Pick-up. Last month, we mentioned our plan to place bag/waste stations around the city in a three-way partnership between the City Council, Carpinteria Beautiful and C-DOG. We hope to reduce the unpicked-up poop, and bags left on the ground or placed in neighbor's trash cans.

C-DOG will be purchasing the units which will be installed by the City and serviced by Carp beautiful.

Similar to the bag dispenser partnerships the City has run for years, the units will be customized to include a photo and the name of your dog. The cost per unit is \$500.
